



XPath Basics

➢_ Select an element by ID

```
//[@id='elementId']
```

➢_ Select an element by name

```
//[@name='elementName']
```

➢_ Select an element by class

```
//[@class='elementClass']
```

➢_ Select all elements with a specific tag name

```
//tagName
```

XPath Axes

➢_ Select the parent element

```
/..
```

➢_ Select all child elements

```
/*
```

➢_ Select the following sibling element

```
/following-sibling::*
```

➢_ Select the preceding sibling element

```
/preceding-sibling::*
```

XPath Predicates

➢_ Select the nth element

```
//element[n]
```

➢_ Select elements based on text content

```
//element[text()='text']
```

➢_ Select elements based on attribute value

```
//element[@attribute='value']
```

➢_ Select elements where attribute contains a value

```
//element[contains(@attribute, 'value')]
```

CSS Selectors

➢_ Select an element by ID

```
#elementId
```

➢_ Select an element by class

```
.elementClass
```

➢_ Select an element by tag name

```
tagName
```

CSS Combinators

➢_ Select child elements

```
parent > child
```

➢_ Select descendant elements

```
ancestor descendant
```

➢_ Select sibling elements

```
element1 + element2
```

➢_ Select general sibling elements

```
element1 ~ element2
```

Advanced Techniques

➢_ Using XPath functions (e.g., starts-with)

```
//element[starts-with(@attribute, 'value')]
```

➢_ Using CSS pseudo-classes (e.g., :nth-child)

```
element:nth-child(n)
```

➢_ Selecting elements based on position

```
//element[last()]
```

➢_ Combining XPath and CSS Selectors (browser specific)

Note: Combining is generally not recommended for cross-browser compatibility
